Parents should log into LIONEL 2, click on the **appointments link on the front page** and select the most convenient time. Students will have just completed their wellbeing questionnaire and this could be an excellent opportunity for the school/ parents to work together to help in any areas identified by the survey. Students will prepare for this Student-led Conference in their tutor time and come prepared to discuss progress with parents and their tutor.
